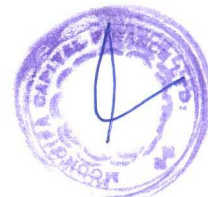

AAP says poll diaries manipulated, Delhi election body denies charge

The Assam Aom Party (AAP) on Friday alleged that the election commission had got polling diaries manipulated by changing officers in the South Delhi parliamentary seat after the general election held on May 12.

The poll commission, however, refuted the allegations and said the Delhi chief election officer would meet some leaders of the AAP on Saturday to clear their doubts.

Adding a press conference on Friday, AAP spokesperson Bharat Bhargava said the party had received 'credible information' about alleged poll code violation. The same allegation was levelled by AAP South Delhi candidate Rajesh Chahal who said that polling officers were being summoned by the EC and are being asked to 're-write' and 're-sign' EVM-related



documents. Both the leaders, however, did not substantiate the charges with any documents.

Polling diaries are used to maintain activity at each booth on polling day. On Saturday, AAP leaders Sanjay Singh and Gaurav Dholakia will file the party's complaint to the chief election commissioner and the Delhi CEC.

A senior poll official said that the return officers (ROs) are 'well' within their powers to summon polling officers in case any irregularity is noticed on the election day. There is

The AAP leader alleged that in the past two days (including officers from Anshul Singh and Bishnu Prasad) had been called.

Sudhakar Srivastava, the returning officer of South Delhi constituency said 'misinformation' is being spread by politicians.

The Bharatya Janata Party (BJP) on Friday said that the AAP is starting to defect and hence were sending misleading allegations.

The BJP said that the ruling party in Delhi has a habit of blaming the election commission and the voting process, as it had done by blaming the EVMs responsible for the alleged manipulation in 2013.

Delhi BJP leader in-charge Prakash Kumar said 'by sending charges against the election commission, they have proved that they are manipulating', he said.

Firefighters rescue 18 from a burning Daryaganj building

A team of fire fighters from Delhi Fire Service saved the lives of 18 persons who were rescued to their fire-station residential building in Daryaganj after a fire in the ground floor parking caught fire, blocking the only way out during the early hours of Friday.

While residents on the first and second floors were made to jump on the mattresses, others struck on the floor above had to be led with a rope and were brought down through a ladder. No casualties were reported in the incident.

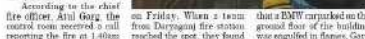
According to the chief fire officer, Ajit Singh, the control room received a call reporting the fire at 1:40am

and four other cars and two two-wheelers were also parked there but had not caught the fire.

Chief said that the team realised that at least 15-18 people are trapped in the building and therefore called for additional manpower.

Manoj Kumar, senior assistant fire officer from the Connaught Place fire station who was also rushed to the spot to manage the rescue operation, said since the fire was in the front of the building, he got a ladder on the roof and cut into the building.

Chief said that the fire could have led to a major disaster, but the staff from the Daryaganj fire station acted quickly and six fire tenders

added to contain the fire. While seven-odd of our men were rescuing the occupants, others tried to put out the fire by 'soak' Pradeep Singh, who lives on the third floor of the building, said that he and his wife along with two children had managed to get out of the building.

Chief said that the fire had started from an electrical wire installed on the ground floor where all the vehicles are parked

Bike collides with cow, it goes rider to death

A 27-year-old man was allegedly found to death by a stray cow after his bike hit the animal in west Delhi's Indraprastha on Thursday evening. According to police, the incident took place at D-10, Prakash Bhatti Marg when the victim, Rakesh, was riding his motorcycle. A police officer said, 'Tender was going from his home to Tughlakpur when the stray cow came in his way before he could get to the police station'.

Locals told police that the cow was led by the woman who had been bitten the victim attacked the cow with its horns and tipped through the fence.

He was rushed to a nearby hospital where he was declared brought dead, 'the officer said. Deputy commissioner of police (west), Manish Bhargava said, a cow of unknown breed that is registered has been registered. 'We are probing if the stray animal belonged to anyone. CCTV is also being checked to establish the sequence of incidents,' Bhargava said.

Plan to translocate trees paves way for 3 housing projects in South Delhi

Three of seven government housing projects in south Delhi that were embedded in a controversy since 2010 because the original proposal called for the felling more than 18,000 trees, have been recommended for clearance by the Union government's expert appraisal committee (EAC) in last two months, according to sources. The projects are located in North Okhla, South Okhla and Barastha Nagar colonies. It showed the first two of the projects are approved and the third is under final approval. The projects had already been recommended for clearance by the committee in January. According to these plans, fewer trees are to be felled, and a large number are to be translocated. A March 25, 2015, EAC report showed that a pilot committee of all-India Forest Department and Central Public Works Corporation (CPWD) had, in 2017, found that of the 1,732 trees proposed to be translocated from Pragati Market, less than 10% would survive the process. Following large-scale protests by citizens group over the proposal for the seven General Post Residential Accommodation (GPRA) projects last year, Union housing and urban affairs minister, Hardeep Singh Puri, had asserted that the plan — in which localised housing is being replaced by high-rise apartments — would be revised to minimise the felling of trees. The EAC chairman can conditionally approve the plan if the 82K Madhav Vihar in India case being heard by the Delhi high court.

Unpaid for 2 months, striking Hindu Rao doctors move HC

In the wake of the strike by doctors at the Hindu Rao Hospital, a plea has been filed in the Delhi High Court on Friday seeking directions to the North Delhi Municipal Corporation to disburse salaries for March and April 2015. The application, filed through advocate Ashish Aggarwal, comes in a pending PIL by Social Justice, an NGO, which had sought directions to the civic body to release salaries of the primary teachers in the North and East Delhi Municipal Corporation (EDMC). The plea, said around 1,000 doctors, including residential doctors employed for five months, have gone on strike due to the non-payment of salaries — as much as 1,000 doctors in the residential doctors working in the North Delhi Municipal Corporation and hospitals have not been paid salaries for the months of March and April 2015 till date. In addition, residential doctors at Hindu Rao Hospital have gone on strike from May 16. '... the plea said. The doctors have been on three-four 'pen-down' strikes since Thursday striking doctors at the hospital said they will stop working completely, then. Monday onwards if they do not receive their salaries. Dr. Sangeeta Choudhary, general secretary, resident doctors welfare association, said, 'The additional commissioner/public health officer north corporation, Jayant Nair, comes to meet us on Friday. He only said that he hasn't got money from the Delhi government and are unable to pay us, so we will have to go to the courts.' 'We are unable to find our families because our salaries have been pending for so long. We have also written to the National Human Rights Commission (NHRC) to get the corporation to pay us.' Dr. Rohini Choudhary said.

North corp writes to Delhi govt asking for ₹ 385 cr first quarter tax dues

Addy after resident doctors at Bero Hindu Rao Hospital declared a 'pen-down' strike over alleged delay in salary, the North Delhi Municipal Corporation Friday wrote to the Delhi government to provide the first quarter of tax dues — ₹385.60 crore — immediately so as to facing a financial crisis. The north body says Bero Hindu Rao Hospital, the residential doctors at the hospital have alleged that they have not been paid salaries since March. The civic body officials said that the money should have been paid in April, but the North Delhi Municipal Corporation (NDMC) has not received the first quarter Non-Plan Grant in Aid claims for the current year 2014-15 as reported as the corporation is yet to pay salary to its teachers, who have not been paid salaries and other staff for the month of March and April 2015, besides the pension of the retired employees, it says.
